


# Organization

The **General Assembly** is the supreme governing body of the SEPR and it meets at least once a year. The Board of Directors is, by delegation and in representation of the General Assembly, the executive body. To carry out its activities, the Society is structured around four standing Work Committees:

- Institutional affairs.
- Scientific activities.
- Communications and publications.
- Economic and financial affairs.



## WORK GROUPS

The Committees may propose to the Board of Directors the creation of temporary Work Groups to undertake specific projects or the Board may set up additional Work Groups when it seems advisable. The person in charge of each group will belong to the Committee to which the group is assigned or to the Board of Directors.

## FORUMS

The Medical Radiation Protection Forum and the Industrial Radiation Protection Forum report directly to the Board of Directors. Their purpose is to create a channel for relations between the Radiation Protection professionals in both areas and the Regulatory Body (CSN), outside the regulatory framework, to develop professional criteria in areas of mutual interest.



*The SRPS is an umbrella organization for all the professionals in this field and offers a space for dialogue, information and participation between its members, society as a whole, and the public and private companies and institutions connected with the peaceful use of ionizing radiations.*

*The SRPS is a member of the International Radiation Protection Association (IRPA) and actively takes part in its activities, as well as in its governing bodies. In addition, it maintains close relations with sister societies in other countries and with the most relevant international organizations in this field, e.g. ICRP, IAEA, OMS, NEA-OECD, etc.*




# Objectives

## ACTIVITIES



The Radiation Protection activities are programmed on an annual basis and are described in an Activity Plan that is submitted to the members for approval, and to the Spanish organizations connected with SEPR for their information.

### CONGRESSES

The SEPR holds its ordinary congress every two years, and on that occasion it convenes all its members and collaborators to review the state of radiation protection and similar sciences, as well as their practical application to each of the different sectors.

In 2004, the SEPR organized the 11<sup>th</sup> World Congress of the International Radiation Protection Association (IRPA 11), an historic milestone of its international congresses.

### COURSES, MEETINGS AND SEMINARS

The SEPR organizes courses, scientific-technical meetings, seminars and conferences on specific current issues that affect radiation protection professionals.

### COLLABORATION WITH AUTHORITIES AND INSTITUTIONS

The SEPR collaborates with institutions, public agencies and authorities, where a large part of that collaboration focuses on regulatory aspects and regulations. For example, the SEPR is a member of the International Radiation Protection Association (IRPA), and it maintains close relations with the *Consejo de Seguridad Nuclear* (CSN) and the Ministry of Health and Consumption, as well as with ENRESA (national radioactive waste company), UNESA (electric utility sector organization), universities, research centers and professional associations.

It is also a member of the Confederation of Scientific Societies of Spain (COSCE) and collaborates with the Spanish Societies of Medical Physics, Nuclear Medicine, Medical Radiology and Radiotherapeutic Oncology and the Spanish Nuclear Society.




