# Trust Is Built Through.....

- Honesty
  - *Telling others the “truth”*
- Integrity
  - *No self delusion*

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## What Is the Truth?.....

- Reality is what ever is real.
- Truth describes my own (or someone else's) reality.
- But we need insight....
  - *"Insight means that we will not be so unaware of ourselves that we can sabotage our own success."*

- be respectful

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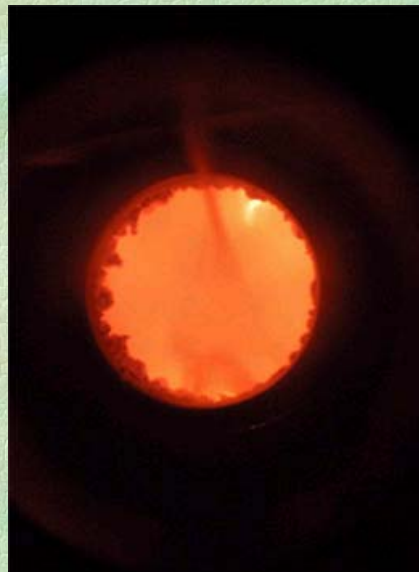
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## Share what you get right.....
